JAPAN

with NEW MEXICO 4-H!

- Who:** 4-H youth ages 16-19 (must turn 16 by the date of travel)
- What:** Travel to Japan with 4-H youth from across the U.S. (Adult chaperones on international flights and in Japan). Live with a Japanese host family during your stay.
- When:** July 9 to August 7, 2008
- When:** One night Departure Orientation in Seattle prior to flight to Tokyo where there will be an Arrival Orientation to introduce you to Japan.
- How:** This exchange is coordinated with 3 different Japanese organizations: Labo Foundation, LEX Institute, and Utrek International Exchange Center. Please see your 4-H Coordinator for more details on each organization's program.
- Cost:** Approximately \$3000 - \$3500 (depending on round trip airfare)
Includes:
- Orientations in Seattle & Tokyo
 - Medical Insurance
 - In-Japan expenses (transportation, lodging, all meals, etc.)

Payment schedule:

- February 1st - \$350 deposit
- April 15 - \$2000 (or remaining balance if less than \$2000)
- May 15 - remaining balance

Cancellation Policy:

- Airfare is non-refundable once issued
- Cancellations must be made in writing
- Cancellations made between June 6 to July 1: Fee of \$400 + airfare if issued
- Cancellations made from July 1 to departure date: Fee of \$700 + airfare
- For the Nihongo Program, cancellations made from June 6 to departure date: Fee of \$1100 + airfare
- For exceptional circumstances, refunds are made on a case-by-case basis

Application due in New Mexico State 4-H Office by January 1, 2008. If applicant accepted, the application will be forwarded to WorldWide by February 1 and must be accompanied by \$350 deposit.
