# Costa Rica

with NEW MEXICO 4-H!

- Who:** 4-H youth ages 16-18 (must turn 16 by the date of travel)
- What:** Travel to Costa Rica with 4-H youth from across the U.S. (an adult chaperone will also travel with the group). Live with a Costa Rican host family during your stay. The 4-week program will include 4-days at camp with 250 Costa Rican 4-H'ers.
- When:** June 21 – July 19, 2008
- Where:** Departure Orientation in Dallas prior to flight to San Jose, Costa Rica where there will be an Arrival Orientation to introduce you to the country and culture.
- How:** This exchange is coordinated with the Fundacion Nacional de Clubes 4S who will organize the Arrival Orientation and the host family stays.
- Cost:** \$1000 + airfare from home states to San Jose with a stopover in Dallas (\$600 - \$1000)  
Includes:
- Pre-trip conference calls
  - Orientations in Dallas & San Jose
  - Medical Insurance
  - In-Costa Rica expenses: transportation, lodging, meals
  - Field trip to the rain forest
  - 3 nights 4 days at a 4-S camp

**Application due in New Mexico State 4-H Office by January 1, 2008.** If applicant accepted, the application will be forwarded to WorldWise by February 1 and must be accompanied by \$350 deposit.

**Cancellation Policy:**

- Airfare is non-refundable once issued
- Cancellations must be made in writing
- Cancellations made between May 1 – 31: Fee of \$350 + airfare if issued
- No refund after May 31
- For exceptional circumstances, refunds are made on a case-by-case basis
